"Amazing."... that's what one visitor wrote about Off The Hookah. In fact, the writer of that review enthused that Off **the Hookah** has ".... Amazing food, amazing shows, and 23 flavors of hookah. You're going to have a great ... great time. The furniture is awesome. Try to reserve a bed. It's really, really nice. I loved it. To be seated outside it's great too. There's an amazing view." Well, this guy was realllly amazed, that's for sure.

Off The Hookah definitely offers a bit of the "wild side" when it comes to entertainment with a unique Mediterranean atmosphere featuring bartenders spitting fire as they wow the crowed. Oh yes, sometimes there are belly dancers. "You may even see real live camels when we have second-to-none parties that really make you think you are taking a walk through the wild side of South Florida," said **Manny Arroyo**, director of marketing. Well, if that's not a bit wild, what is?

The 14,000-square-foot nightclub, with its **Egyptian** theme décor, derives its name because of the close to two dozen hookahs scattered around the room. One person described the ancient smoking apparatus as something you can "... smoke flavored tobacco from ... a water pipe called a hookah ... that has four hoses to smoke from." Manny says there are actually 25 flavors, but the combinations are limitless.

The club, open Wednesday through Sunday from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., boasts five VIP areas, a large dance floor and a covered outdoor patio with a totally different Asian theme and atmosphere. Ask about their special group packages.

The Tequesta Drum Circle invites folks to "Rekindle. Reconnect. Enjoy. Meditate. Make friends." The next gathering, for the vernal equinox, will be on March 20 from 7 p.m. to midnight.

Bring your own seating, food, drinks and bug spray. Fire spinning (fire poi) is not allowed, but spinning with LED poi is welcomed. The evening does not allow pets, alcohol or drugs, and children under 18 must have an adult with them. The entrance fee is \$10 per person.

## DR. SKETCHY'S ANTI-ART SCHOOL

O AN EVENING OF SKETCHING AND ENTERTAINMENT

For a truly different night out where you can get in touch with your creative side, visit **Dr. Sketchy's Anti-Art Schoo**l in Fort Lauderdale. Partly an evening of entertainment and partly artist's night out, this alternative drawing movement offers a chance to sketch a live **model**.

"The most popular version (of the evening) is **burlesque dancers** who perform and model," said **Charlotte**  Sundquist, self prescribed sketchy person in charge/ independent curator of the local chapter of the "anti-art" school. But don't worry ... the models keep their clothes on and frequently dress in costumes that make drawing more interesting. Florida's professional mermaids have posed for the evenings.

According to its website, "Dr. Sketchy's Anti-Art school is the world's premier **alt**  drawing movement. Artists draw glamorous underground performers in an atmosphere of boozy conviviality. Founded in 2005 in a dive bar in Brooklyn, Dr. Sketchy's has now spread to over100 cities around the world."

Attendees bring their own art supplies, including paper or canvas, pencils or paint. Admission is \$10 in advance, \$12 at the door, for the threehour live drawing session. The evening's drawing sessions last five to 20 minutes each to put your artistic flow to paper.

Anyone who has taken formal art lessons knows sketching live models, even nude ones, can be a bit, well, boring. "It was always a very stoic atmosphere, concentrating on the musculature," Sundquist said. Dr. Sketchy's founder felt that kind of sketching "really wasn't a lot of fun."

So Dr. Sketchy's was born. "It's not necessarily just for

The Copacabana Supper Club in Downtown Fort Lauderdale brings a sizzling Latin spice to the area. "Copa girls" and a 10-piece band will be performing nightly, starting on Jan. 13.

#### GETTING UP CLOSE AND PERSONAL WITH FLORIDA'S WILDLIFE SY KATIE DRESSLER

Befitting of the theme Fort Lauderdale's Wild Side, I thought it would be the perfect opportunity to lend insight (and for some, an introduction) to a truly wild activity in South Florida known as herping. In the most general sense, herping refers to searching for reptiles and amphibians; but for many, herping denotes both a meaning and value that extends far beyond what you would find its dictionary definition – for dedicated herpers, it's all about the experience.

South Florida is unique in its ability to boast the famed **River of Grass**, also known as the **Everglades**. And while the Everglades does not technically fall within the geographic parameters of Fort Lauderdale, it is close enough that Fort Lauderdale residents and visitors can easily access the delicate **ecosystem** in order to gain further insight into its many species of inhabitants.

For those who are interested in going herping or want to learn more about it, South Florida provides ample resources. However, please note that unless you are fully informed regarding the specific rules and regulations set forth to protect our beloved wildlife, make sure any herping you do is in accordance with both state and federal laws – **viewing** from a safe distance is allowed, but make sure not to touch, disturb or harass the wildlife.


Many organizations will offer guided tours to allow those less familiar with the legalities to still enjoy the experience. Everglades Natural Park hosts programs such as Starlight Walk, Car Caravan and Glades Glimpse, which allow visitors to enjoy herping in a more guided and informative setting. Another opportunity for herping in a guided fashion is to attend one of Clyde Butcher's popular Swamp Walks. The famed Everglades photographer takes attendees on a trek through the Everglades where they can witness the wildlife in its most natural state, accompanied by an

ever-passionate guide who chose to make the Everglades his home. For some who are more

experienced with herping and carry the proper permits and/ or certification, the herping experience is all about venturing into the wilderness with a flashlight and a group of close of friends in order to experience the natural wonders of the local wildlife in a smaller, intimate setting. Fort Lauderdale native and herping enthusiast Ryan Martinez explains his philosophy as "We go out there and take nothing but photographs, memories and mosquito bites. We make sure to watch from a safe distance but we all love it because reptiles and amphibians have unique adaptations that are different from other species. Herping allows us to witness these fascinating creatures in their natural setting."

What has four wheels, one driver but 20 pedals? The newest form of transportation to hit Fort Lauderdale streets. Add some laughter, music and a little sweat and you've got a cycle party!

Chris Haerting and business partner Simon Fernandez have spearheaded the Cycle Party concept in South Florida, specifically Downtown Fort Lauderdale. The 15-seat bike is as green as it gets, made entirely of aluminum for lightweight agility, and runs purely on the energy and enthusiasm of peddling patrons, equaling no emissions. Behaved pets are even welcome. The idea is already quite popular in Europe but originally started in Germany, where Haerting's parents, **Michael Haerting** and **Aileen Brousseau** live. They introduced him to the "bier bike" concept and he ran with it, creating Cycle Party within just the past year.

Projects like Cycle Party have already hit America in approximately 25 cities across the nation. While in the process of securing the appropriate permits, Haerting hopes to soon frequent spots on **Himmarshee**, Las Olas and the **beach** and anticipates being available for private hire as well as public tours around the city. Pub crawls and tailgating are also foreseeable future options for patrons.

"It doesn't have to revolve around drinking. There are a lot of corporate team building events that we can do. We get a lot of calls for bachelor and bachelorette parties, birthday parties, promotional events, and progressive dinners," Haerting said.

Cycle Party has frequented the gamut of outdoor festivities this year ranging from Coral Gables Bike Day to Winterfest's Family Fun Day. Elizabeth Stewart was first introduced to the concept at **Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale's Rocktoberfest** with her husband and friends. "It's interactive, it's fun, and it's something you could do with a group of friends or just even random people. It's just like you're sitting at a bar, but it's a little more engaging," she said.

Cycle Party, now approved and welcome in Fort Lauderdale, is making moves in all the ways relevant to locals and their city — introducing a new trendy way to travel, socialize, exercise and go green all at the same time.

C RACING WITH WILLY WONKA S BY BRITTNEY MESSINGSCHLAGER

It's seems there is some kind of race, 5K, triathlon or marathon popping up every weekend these days. I guess that's one of the joys of living in South Florida were the weather is beautiful more often than not. But after a while, how many 5Ks can you run around the cement jungles of Downtown without getting a little bored? That's when it hit me - with a pop of color!

This past October, I became a Color Runner and now I'm hooked. Color runs are popping up all over the country with 5Ks like the Color Vibe, Color Me Rad and Color Run 5K, which is set to take place in Fort

Lauderdale on May 5, exact location to be announced soon.

The purpose of color running is to turn an early morning 5K run or walk into a loud, energetic and colorful event in which you get doused in color with each kilometer completed. The nontoxic color powder is made of food grade quality cornstarch that is colored to the brightest possible hues of yellow, pink, blue, green and any color you may find in a rainbow.

Runners are encouraged to wear all white, costumes and even tutus. By the end of the 5-kilometer race, participants have run through at least five



different color stations and cross the finish line looking they just ran through a **rainbow** and out the back door of Willy Wonka's Chocolate Factory. It really is a blast; no wonder The Color Run's motto is **"The Happiest 5K on the Planet."** 

So gather a team and gear up for the Color Run coming to Fort Lauderdale on May 5 or volunteer with Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale to support the event.

South Florida is no stranger to the world of water sports. Kayaking, jet skiing, parasailing you name it, Fort Lauderdale has it. Ideal weather conditions and ample beach property are features that adventure enthusiast crave and, again — Fort Lauderdale has it covered, which is why it's no surprise that its shores are seeing the increase of a newer water sport — kite boarding.

Jesse Cors of Liquid Surf and Sail, a former windsurfer, began professionally kite boarding in his hometown of Fort Lauderdale back in 2001 around the time the sport became mainstream. Now, second in popularity only to paddle boarding, kite boarding has created its very own culture.

"Kite boarding is basically taking a wake board-style board ... and

the ability of a kite, much bigger than your average beach kite that you play with," Cors said. The caught wind pulls the surfer along the water and allows him/her to glide over the surface. "A lot of people describe it as wake boarding behind a helicopter," he said.

The required equipment can be quite extensive and the investment, arguably expensive. Cors breaks it down into three major components: the kite, along with the control bar and kite lines; the harness, used to attach the body to the kite; and the board, which can range from surf boards, skim boards, or twin tip style boards. A package deal could set you back anywhere in between \$1,500 and \$3,000.

Cors recommends first-timers start with beginners' lessons. One-

on-one instruction typically runs \$75 to \$100 an hour and covers launching and surfing techniques, wind theory, safety precautions and information on how to take advantage of location specific conditions. Other than a great surf break, Fort Lauderdale affords kite boarders a launch area at the southern part of the beach that allows non-motorized vessels to launch and land.

Be prepared to hear more from this sport. "[Kite boarding] is only about 12 years old. That's an infant in the sporting world," Cors said. "Every year there's a ton of technological advances and things are changing rapidly, which is kind of fun."












Visit Fort Lauderdale's Fascinating City Under the Sea



id you know the Greater Fort Lauderdale area is home to more than 100 dive sites and was recognized with the Top 10 World's Best

Awards for wreck diving and marine Life by Scuba Diving Magazine? Although I am an avid scuba diver, I recently learned this.

From Deerfield Beach to Hallandale Beach, there are more than 75 artificial reefs that have been placed on the ocean floor over the past 20 years, attracting amazing marine life from the tinniest **seahorses** to graceful sea turtles. This unique natural three-tiered **reef system** begins in just 20 feet of water and located 100 yards offshore, making many sites accessible right from the beach. The best shore diving (beach) sites are located right off the shore on Datura Avenue in Lauderdaleby-the-Sea, and regarded by many as the "Best Shore Dive in Florida."

Tourists visit Fort Lauderdale from all over the world to escape their winters and enjoy our balmy season.

By taking a private boat or dive charter, you can see some of the best wrecks and reefs within minutes of the leaving the shore. Weekday trips are my favorite, as boats and superb dive sites are less crowded than on weekends.

• Robert Edminster, a 95-foot Coast Guard Cutter sunk in December 1989, sits upright in 70 feet of water,

• Hog Heaven, a 180-foot barge sunk in September 1986 and rests upside down in just 64-feet of water with a 1,200 foot long pile of concrete pipes just south of the wreck,

• The Copenhagen: although there is not much left to this 325-foot steel hull, this dive site has been designated a State Marine Archeological Preserve and is home to lots of nice tropical fish, lobster, snapper and grouper and rests in only 15 to 30 feet of water.

Fort Lauderdale is on Florida's natural reef line, which is the third largest **natural coral reef** in the world, and provides a natural habitat for a plethora of marine life, making for awesome drift dives. "My wife and I moved from England to Florida in 2006, we have global diving experience and have been **impressed** with the quality of diving in the Fort Lauderdale area," said Rob Davis, PADI Master scuba diver trainer. "The **artificial reefs** (wrecks) are just a short 15 minute boat trip from the dock, but more importantly because they have been down there a number of years they're all covered with phenomenal growth. They have also been colonized with **marine life** with the occasional bigger visitors such as goliath groupers, black groupers, turtles, nurse sharks even manta rays for the truly fortunate divers."

So what are you waiting for? There is no better time to get out of your depth and visit Fort Lauderdale's fabulous city under the sea. (1)



# A Kickin' Good Time

Fort Lauderdale's Newest Downtown Kickball League Stirs the Competition and Supports the Community

uizenga Plaza was a little noisier this fall. Sandwiched between the Museum of Art | Fort Lauderdale and the New River, Mondays in November, the green sported portable bright lights after dusk ... though not of the festive kind. It was kickball season Downtown and friends, family members, co-workers and strangers gathered for some friendly competition and spirited camaraderie.

The official Downtown Fort Lauderdale kickball league is a partnership between Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale, WAKA Social Sports, Downtown Development Authority and the City of Fort Lauderdale. The idea for a downtown league was inspired at Dicey Riley's where the Mills Pond group celebrated after finishing a kickball game. Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale collaborated with Jonathan Korb, vice president of the South Florida WAKA leagues. "Our saying is 'best parties, best games, best friends," he said. A portion of the proceeds incurred from the league went directly to Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale. "It was a good fit for us because WAKA tries to give back," Korb said.

Six teams totaling about 100 people came out dressed in **appropriate apparel** for each themed week. For the kickoff game, on Oct. 29, **John P. "Jack" Seiler** pitched the ceremonial first ball as the **Downtown Ballers** and 4 **More SREEB** took to the field. For Seiler, it was reminiscent of his adolescent days playing kickball at St. Anthony's Catholic School just a few blocks away, except this time instead of schoolyard asphalt, Seiler was pitching on the Huizenga green. "It's a fantastic way to move people to the Riverwalk," he said. "It's great for our city (and) just what we envisioned."

Each game began with a "rock, paper, scissors" faceoff and consisted of 50 minutes or five innings of playing time. The rules are modeled off of baseball with some additional twists. During the third inning either Korb or Michael Luppowitz, another officiating WAKA representative, introduced some unconventional rules such as running the bases backward. According to Luppowitz, this heightens the team bonding experience. "Our job is to show people how to have a good time," he said.

For Melody and Jeremy Langley, of the Straight Ballin' team, joining the league was happenstance. After someone at Briny's Pub the night of the kickoff party mistook them for players, the couple decided to sign up for the league and came to the first game dressed as Bat Woman and Wolverine. "I think it gets people out," She said of the league. "You have the ability to meet new people and make new friends. It gives you something to do, which is nice, oh and a little exercise."

Katrina Dannhein joined the Straight Ballin' team with her co-worker Ben. Both just moved into South Florida a few weeks before and thought participating in the league would be a great way to meet new people.

After the final Dec. 3 game, Life's a Pitch and Straight Ballin' came out on top, tying for the season's first place spot. Bases Are Loaded and DTF snagged second and third place, respectively.

ou cannot miss with one of the newest restaurants in downtown Fort Lauderdale. Rice and Dough is exactly what it sounds like, and far more than you would expect. Husband and wife team Amy and Goran Perovic have created an American restaurant featuring two of our favorite cuisines. Their concept is simple. They have created a place that is comfortable, casual and stylish. The cuisine, as the name suggests, is a combination of the best flavors of Asia and Italy. Not together, of course, but described on two separate menus.

It is light and refreshing. The natural fresh flavor of this combination requires no additional seasoning or sauce, except the squeeze of lemon that is presented with the dish. **O**ITALIAN
