



- residents congregating to play chess, checkers or corn hole (yes, it really is a game)
- hundreds of diners at waterfront restaurants up and down the New River

To achieve this critical mass of activity we need to enhance our Park. That calls for simple things like improved lighting and shade trees. Further, we need to give our residents and visitors more reasons to come to the River — even if it is just a game of bocce or to grab an ice cream cone.

The first 25 years of Riverwalk have been essential to its physical creation and establishment as a desirable venue. The next 25 years are critical to give the Riverwalk the attention and care it needs to elevate it to the status it and our City deserve. Hospitable Downtown Adds Magic to Retail Mix

thriving city attracts a steady stream of new businesses, and judging by the influx, Downtown is looking pretty robust. There is a great need for diversity in retail and experiences that are always new and exciting. It's through this mix that the magic is created and keeps folks coming back for more. The DDA is currently exploring the question of what population density is needed to support a diverse retail environment. One area of the Downtown economy that continues to be very active is hospitality. A new generation of eating and drinking establishments geared toward young professionals has arrived. These places cater to a discerning set of folks who appreciate hand-crafted drinks, sophisticated meals, artisan bread, craft beers, finely brewed coffee and elaborate cocktails.

Here are some of the exciting new additions of the new restaurants and bars in Downtown.

Bar Stache 1920s Drinking Den and The Grind Coffee Project

Stache is the atmospheric new speakeasy that now inhabits the former Green Room space at the Revolution Live complex. Channel Al Capone, a frequent visitor to Fort Lauderdale, and enjoy cocktails from the era, courtesy of the bar mixologists. Happy hour and tapas are also available, but if you're not in the mood for alcohol, there's also plenty of a different kind of brew. here's one hub in Fort Lauderdale that is THE place in town for the year's biggest parties. Fivethousand revelers descended on this spot this past Halloween and that number pales compared to what this entertainment district will see come New Year's Eve. Then lookout on St. Patrick's Day ... the biggest party of the year happens not on the beach and not on Las Olas Boulevard, Downtown's main thoroughfare.

Ground zero for those who know where to find the best parties is Downtown Himmarshee Village. Known for years as nightclub party central, Himmarshee Village is now growing up. Infused with new restaurants, an expanded performing arts center, and a burgeoning science museum, all against the scenic backdrop of the Riverwalk and the New River, this historic district is poised for even more growth.

New Dining and Entertainment Breathe New Life to Historic District

One person fueling that growth is Marc Falsetto, owner of J.E.Y. Hospitality, the group behind the gourmet burger pub ROK:BRGR and the latest installment on the street, Himmarshee Public House. This newest hotspot combines a restaurant, sporting lounge and late-night entertainment center all in one. (See Dining Destination profile on Page 36.)

"We are located in the middle of Himmarshee Village and sitting in the oldest office building in Broward County," Falsetto said. "This used to be the Boston Shoe Company in the 30s. So we decided to use the name Himmarshee to revitalize the history. And Public House is the old school term for neighborhood pub. With that being said, "Himmarshee Public House was born."


Why Himmarshee District? "There are several factors. First, I already own a restaurant on the street and love the diverse clientele that being in Downtown Fort Lauderdale provides. The proximity to the performing arts center and the museum are great. I am a history junkie and love the historical aspect of it. We really want to revitalize the street and put it on the map for dining and not just college kids partying. Something about Himmarshee that Las Olas doesn't have ... and that is energy."

The Himmarshee Historic District is the oldest section of the commercial Downtown. It includes early 20th century businesses located along the north and south sides of Himmarshee/Second Street. The district is bounded on the north by Broward

Boulevard, the south by the New River, the east by the FEC railroad tracks and the west by Southwest Fourth Avenue.

The area has seen its ups and downs through the years, most recently known for attracting the young crowd who thinks nothing of partying until the wee hours. "It's the only part of Fort Lauderdale that is open until 4 in the morning," Falsetto said. "That's the place to go."

The Second Street district has not always been such a popular spot. Fort Lauderdale native and author Deborah Sharp shares her memories. "I've seen the transition from seedy to swanky," said Sharp, who was born and raised here. "The area used to be really dicey, with a couple of rough bars, boarding houses for the down-and-out, and second-hand shops along Southwest Second Street.

"Back in the late 70s or early 80s I came home from graduate school to visit my family. The weather was

beautiful, so I took a bike ride along the river — no paved Riverwalk or charming restaurants in those days. A police squad car pulled up, blocking my path. The cop motioned me to his window and told me I was nuts, riding my bike alone in that neighborhood. Even though it was broad daylight, he said I should pedal as fast as I could to a safer spot.

"I still ride a bicycle through the area, but now the biggest danger is dodging the swarm of Sunday brunch crowds."

Those crowds go beyond Sunday brunch, 3 a.m. partying and fine dining. The Broward Center for the Performing Arts is in the midst of a capital project that will renovate, renew, revitalize and redefine the Broward Center for the future. The theaters will be restored to state-of-the-art-caliber. Technology will be integrated throughout the campus. Education facilities will be expanded to accommodate the growth of its arts-in-education programs, and dining and

entertainment areas will be added.

One of those areas just opened in November, the Silver Airways Intermezzo Lounge. This first-class theater experience is available during all evening performances and weekend matinees in the Au-Rene Theatre. Located on the upper-orchestra level of the Au-Rene Theater, the Silver Airways Intermezzo Lounge will be open one hour before each performance and during intermissions

for an admission price of \$30 to be sold separately from theater tickets. The admission price includes complimentary soft drinks, premium beer, wine and Silver Airways' signature pink champagne along with coffee, tea, and a delicious selection of appetizers and desserts (mixed drinks and spirits are offered at preferred pricing).

"Things have started to come back and there's been a great resurgence" because of the Riverwalk, Broward Center expansion and programming at the Museum of Discovery and Science, said Chuck Bergwin, owner of T-Mex Cantina. He calls himself a "dinosaur" on the street; he opened his restaurant in 2000. "I've been here ever since and am very happy here. I've seen a lot of changes. We were a very eclectic neighborhood of bars and restaurants." Tarpon Bend Fort Lauderdale has been an anchor in the district for years.

New restaurants and clubs have added to the vibrancy. "It's great to see more people coming down here and breathing new life," Bergwin said. "We're getting back to a really nice eclectic mix of restaurants, bars and nightclubs. It's onestop shopping."

And the growth and offerings continue. While Falsetto just launched Public House in November, he's always thinking ahead. "I want to grow that area and do two, possible three more concepts on the street," he said. "I want to bring in dining. I'd like to see more of a dining destination like you see in Charleston or Nashville."

Like Public House's website declares: "Downtown is back." 📵

Turning Inside Out

Take a Look at Fort Lauderdale's Diverse Talent

f you walk around FAT Village, you'll come across the art district's latest creative installation, INSIDE OUT Fort Lauderdale. The first installment, Faces of Art, was designed to celebrate the creativity of the city and to encourage the community to support local art. Thirty-three local artists, who live or work in Fort Lauderdale, from a variety of disciplines and different stages of their careers — musicians, writers, designers, painters and filmmakers shared their faces for these portraits. The goal of Faces of Art was to illustrate the diverse pool of talent creating in our community.

After watching French artist JR speak at the 2011 TED conference, self-taught photographer, Kristina DaSilva, wanted to bring his INSIDE OUT project to Fort Lauderdale. JR's concept of large-format street "pastings" is intended to draw attention to critical social and socioeconomic issues had earned him a \$100,000 prize for his work. He believes it is a global platform for people to share their untold stories and transform messages of personal identity into works of public art.

The project funds were contributed



by local arts and INSIDE OUT project supporters conducting fundraising activities at events such as Revel on the Block last July. They also found incredible support from FAT Village Arts District and landscape architecture and urban design firm, Cadence.

While DaSilva provided oversight, the project was really brought to life by all of the individuals who became a part of it. For Faces of Art, local photographers Emilee Rose McGovern and Jim Zielinski came on

board to help photograph the artists and Cadence donated its studio for the pop-up photo shoot. Local artists Leah Brown and Peter Symons hung the 33 portraits. "From the artists who submitted their stories to the volunteers who pasted portraits and the supporters whose donations made it all possible, it really is the people's art project," DaSilva said. "We engaged people from all backgrounds to participate. Because of that, I think we've been successful in continuing JR's vision."

With the permission of JR's studio in New York, the movie poster-sized portraits debuted in FAT Village during Art Fallout, a community-wide art walk of contemporary art spaces in Downtown Fort Lauderdale curated by Girls' Club. The display is expected to be visible for several months but that all

depends on Mother Nature. The portraits are printed on paper and pasted to wooden panels with wheat paste, a homemade glue; then a protective finish is added to help preserve the images. The completed mosaic of portraits can be seen on the wall on Northwest Fifth Street, between Andrews Avenue and Northwest First Avenue in FAT Village and called for the creation of a global participatory art project with the potential to change the world.


The Christmas Palace, the largest



or as the centerpiece of a beautiful martini, elit makes any party that much better. This elegant vodka is distilled from single-source grain grown in the Central Black Earth region of Russia. Vodka is always a great choice because of its clean character and ability to go well with nearly any food.

Holidays are fantastic times to enjoy a great wine, spirit or cocktail. It doesn't matter which one of the above that you drink, but including them in your celebration will certainly make the party well-worth attending.

We attended a preview menu tasting and

the following dishes were unique in flavor and plating. The Spicy Lamb Ribs were braised and cooked with Abita Root Beer Glaze, sweet and tender pairing perfectly with Funky Buddha Brewery's Hop Gun IPA. The crunchy Bacon and Corn Fritters, topped with bourbon maple syrup and bacon aioli, were hot and fresh, bursting with bacon. Next we sampled the hand crafted Lobster Nachos (perfectly seasoned and crisp) topped with fragrant cilantro, fresh guacamole and a kickass habanera mango salsa. Bacon fans will want to try the house cured and candied pork belly topped with candied pecans and maple syrup. Sweet and sticky. Rounding out the tasting were the maple glazed bonein Lollipop Pork Chops with house mashed potatoes and braised kale. Comfort food heaven.

Next time you are downtown and want lunch, dinner or a late night snack, check out Himmarshee Public House's diverse small plates, burgers, street tacos, global dishes and a plethora of libations. We had no room for dessert!

I met Paula and was immediately impressed with her creativity in preparing not-so-simple dishes bursting with unique flavor profiles. She has earned rave reviews upon her return to 3030 Ocean for her updated menu at the Harbor Beach Marriott's highly-rated restaurant. This fall, she introduced her new menu and invited us to sample her soulful creations.

3030 Ocean, known as a local destination for fresh seafood, will now include Paula's signature style "refined and rustic" soulful cookery. Her precise technique adds an extra element of creativity: "My goal with the new menu is to broaden the scope of 3030's offerings and introduce new dishes, new styles and new inspirations that complement some of the elements that 3030 is known for," she said.

Our dining adventure started with a stunning seafood platter of wild gulf shrimp, ahi tuna poke with crunchy macadamia nuts and a trio of house made dipping sauces that had us going back for seconds.

The outstanding house-made soft mozzarella reminded me of my Sicilian grandma's rustic Burrata amped up with bright heirloom tomato and

an amazing olive basil purée that brought all the elements together. You will not want to share this appetizer.

> > the table. The rustic style bronzino "en papillote" came encased in a paper bag bursting with wild mushrooms, cauliflower, potato and

scallions enrobed in a tart

preserved lemon emulsion.

Desserts were crafted with creamy elements balanced by texture and just the right amount of spice. The warm and decadent Nutella bread pudding was studded with pecans, juicy cherries and cayenne ice cream. The not-so-traditional carrot cake is full of nutty pecans with fresh floral notes of homemade orange ice cream. The tart Key Lime Martini was the perfect ending to an eclectic meal. Chef Paula DaSilva is a culinary powerhouse, demonstrating a dedication to her culinary craft that delights foodies and critics alike. Bravo!

3030 Ocean's Infused Cocktails

3030 Restaurant Manager and cocktail enthusiast Taylor Hall's progressive bar menu caught our eye. We couldn't resist the impressive array of libations crafted by their mixologist. We wanted one of each, but restrained ourselves to four. These libations stood out:

Apple martinis are so 2010, but 3030's salty apple version with caramel vodka and ginger liqueur is a zinger. Sweet and salty with just a hint of spice. The perfect dessert in a glass.

Finn's Ale boasted a tingling pineappleinfused rum with tangy orange wedges and ginger beer.

Playing with Fire's house infused fresh jalapeño tequila with agave and cucumber is both hot and sweet at the same time. This drink wakes up your taste buds and leaves you wanting more.
